

1. KUD Plesarin, Rovini, Croatia



ARTISTIC DIRECTOR: Vladimir Bogosavljević

The "Plesarin" folklore association was founded in May 2005, and has been active in the Rovinj area ever since. It numbers around 30 active members and many more followers. The association's activities focus on the preservation of Istrian folklore. It participates at folklore events in the region, the country and the neighbouring countries of Slovenia and Italy. Apart from the traditional Istrian dances, the Plesarin performs dances from other parts of Croatia as well. The Plesarin folklore association is the proud host and co-organiser of the 2nd FAKS Dance Festival – the International Folklore Festival, which will surely live on to establish a long tradition in our beautiful town.

3. Folklore Association Pazin, Pazin, Croatia

The Pazin Folklore Association actively preserves traditional values. Constant research of the history of Istria inspires us to protect traditional heritage in its most original form possible and present it to younger generations. The activities of the dancing, singing and instrumental sections of the association have been expanded to include the reconstruction of old customs, with constant cooperation with related institutions and associations. They place great emphasis on working with younger people, therefore, they run two sections adapted to different age groups.

4. KUD "Bosna" of the Istria County, Pula, Croatia

The Folklore association "Bosna"of the Istria County was established in 2004. The aim of the association is to provide culture and traditions from their homeland Bosnia and Herzegovina and region of Istria where most of their children are born. Every year they are organizing a few manifestations which are very well accepted from the audience and public, and they are also recognized in all segments of preserving bosnian culture within community. Their main goal is to attract more young people to join their association and to help preserving and not forgetting the culture and customs of neighboring Bosnia and Herzegovina.

6. Bulgarian Folklore Dance Group "Pendari Vienna", Vienna, Austria

The folklore dance group "Pendari Vienna" was established in May 2013 by enthusiasts wishing to celebrate the prolific Bulgarian folklore heritage and contribute to the cultural variety of the Austrian capital. Their repertoire includes beautiful melodic Bulgarian folk songs and original choreographies based on traditional dances from different ethnographic regions of Bulgaria. The folklore ensemble "Pendari Vienna" is a source of positive energy for anyone who wishes to build new friendships. The name of the group is symbolic – as the gold coins (pendari) show off their full splendour when strung together, so do the performers – hand in hand – increase the beauty of the Bulgarian dance. The group has already participated in numerous festivals in Austria and other European countries.

2. Folklore association Vransko, Vransko, Slovenia

The history of Folklorno association Vransko begins in the year 2006.

The folklore group of the Cultural and Educational Society of Lesce is celebrating its tenth anniversary this year. Currently, the group consists of sixteen male and female dancers, three strings and a choreographer. Through their activities, they contribute to the preservation of folk traditions and the revival of ancestral customs. They mainly present Slovene dances and songs recorded in the Gorenje region, and they are also dressed in the Gorenje national costume. They participate in folklore meetings and they are happy to present their rich heritage to foreign guests. Members are united by the desire and joy of dancing, singing, acting and, of course, socializing, all of which keep them flexible and young in heart.
